Requirements for A. B. degree: 120 academic points, exclusive of physical education. A point signifies the completion of work requiring attendance at class 1 hour, or in a laboratory 2 hours, or in a lecture for one-half year (15 weeks).

Grades: A=excellent, B=good, C=fair, D=poor, F=failure, Inc=incomplete, Abs=absent from examination, NR=no report until year's work is completed. In physical education, NR=no requirement, S=substitute work. (i.e., Only 6 points of work of grade D in any one year, or 24 points altogether, may count towards a Barnard degree.)



In September 1937, on the basis of her standing at Barnard during the first two years, and with the approval of the Department of Mathematics, Miss Comer was admitted to the honors course with a major in mathematics. She remained in this course on probation for one year and was admitted, in May 1938, as a candidate for a degree with honors in mathematics.

Honor students are exempt from the technical requirements of 120 points, from the usual regulation of class attendance, which in their cases is under the direction of their major departments, and, in their senior year only, from the customary system of grading.

They are expected to take the regular examinations in the courses for which they are registered in the junior year, but in the senior year, all course examinations in the major subject are omitted, examinations in other subjects being at the option of the major department, and at the end of the year, the students take a comprehensive examination in that subject.
